



## The Charity Ride by the Numbers

- This year marks the **15<sup>th</sup>** anniversary of the Chick-fil-A Kyle Petty Charity Ride Across America.
- Since the Ride's inception in 1995, **6,100** riders have logged more than **7.9 million** cumulative motorcycle miles.
- The Ride has donated more than **\$12 million** for chronically ill children.
- In 2008, the Charity Ride Dream Team Challenge raised more than **\$40,000**.
- As a result of the 2008 Ride's efforts, more than **350** children will attend a five-day session free of charge.
- **Thirteen** riders have participated in all 15 Rides.
- Over the years, the Ride has visited 49 of the 50 states.
- The 2008 route will take riders more than **3,500** miles from Stevenson, Wash., to Greensboro, N.C., in **nine** days.
- Riders will make approximately **six** "Pit Stops" per day.
- It costs more than **\$3,000** for a child to attend Victory Junction Gang Camp for a week. Through the generous support of corporations, organizations and individuals, each camper participates for free.
- Chick-fil-A is the title sponsor of the Ride for the **sixth** year. Riders will consume more than 1,000 Chick-fil-A<sup>®</sup> Chicken sandwiches and 100 gallons of sweet tea on the 2009 Ride.
- Chick-fil-A has sold more than **209 million** Chick-fil-A<sup>®</sup> Chicken sandwiches. Laid end to end, that is more than **13,280** miles of Chick-fil-A<sup>®</sup> Chicken sandwiches.
